Instructions for applying for the CRU scholarship

Eligible Applicants (Spring 2012 only)

Undergraduate students attending Michigan State University:

- Must be enrolled full time for Spring 2012
- Undergraduate students must carry a minimum of 12 credits each semester at MSU and have a 2.5 cumulative GPA.

Applicant Requirements (Spring 2012 only)

Only completed application packets will be accepted.

We will not contact you if your application packet is incomplete.

Completed application packets consist of the following items (in order of importance)

- **Complete application form**
- **Resume**
- **Proof of enrollment:** Official MSU transcripts (sealed from the Office of the Registrar) ***It is free!***
- **Personal Statement essay-** please enclose a 1 to 2 page, typed personal statement in which you must address the following:
 - Demonstration of student leadership, involvement in extracurricular activities, and your involvement with the MSU Chicano/Latino Community.
 - Career goals
 - If you become a recipient of the CRU scholarship, how will you contribute to the MSU Chicano/Latino community in the future?
